The upper age limit shall be relaxed by **05 (five)** years for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes (SC) & Scheduled Tribes (ST) and by **03 (Three)** years for the candidates belonging to the category of Other Backward Classes (OBC).
 - The personnel of West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police having requisite qualifications and age are eligible to apply for the post provided that no departmental candidates shall be allowed to appear in the Competitive Examination more than three times.
- (2) **Educational Qualifications:** The candidate must be a holder of a Bachelor's degree with any of the following subjects: Physics or Radio Physics or Electronics and Telecommunications or Electrical Engineering or Computer Science or Information Technology from any recognized University.
- (3) Candidate should be in good mental and physical health. They should be free from any deformity likely to interfere with efficient performance of their work.
- (4) **Language : -** The applicant must be able to speak, read and write in Bengali language. However, this provision will not be applicable to the persons who are permanent residents of hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts. For the applicant of hill sub-division of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts, the provisions laid down in the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961 will be applicable.
