No. 5369-PL/PB/14M-11/02 (Pt.-I) dated 31/10/2017 : In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing rules if any, on the subject, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the post of Junior Civilian Finger Print Expert in the Finger Print Bureau, C.I.D., West Bengal :-

RULES

The method of and the qualifications required for recruitment to the post of Junior Civilian Finger Print Expert in the Finger Print Bureau, C.I.D., West Bengal shall be as follows :-

(1) Name of the Post :

Junior Civilian Finger Print Expert in the Finger Print Bureau, C.I.D., West Bengal ;

(2) Appointing Authority :

Additional Director General of Police, Criminal Investigation Department, West Bengal ;

(3) Method of Recruitment :

Selection by written test and interview through the P.S.C., West Bengal.

(4) Scheme of Examination & Syllabus :

As at para – 12

(5) Qualification :

The candidate – (i) must be a citizen of India (ii) must be a 'Graduate in Science' of any recognized University of India having with 'Basic knowledge in Computer' .

(6) Age :

The candidate – must have attained the age of 21 years but not more than 36 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January of the year of Advertisement. The Upper age limit is relaxable in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates as per existing rules.

(7)(a) Minimum Physical Requirement :

Before appointment the selected candidates shall be medically examined by the competent Medical Officer with regard to their fitness for the appointment to the post. In addition the candidates must have the following minimum visual standard viz.

		<u>Right Eye</u>	<u>Left Eye</u>
i)	Distant Vision	6/6	6/6 (Shellon)
ii)	Near Viision	0/5	0/5 (Shellon)



(7)(b) Persons with disabilities will be allowed concession as per provision contained in Notification No. 746-SW dated 28/02/2011 of Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare.

(8) Probation :

The selected candidate shall be on probation for 03 (three) years. The appointing authority may extend a probationers prescribed period of probation by such period not exceeding one year as the appointing authority deems appropriate. A probationer shall have to undergo the following schedule of training during the probationary period.

(a)	Training	12 months in the FPB, CID, W.B.
(b)	Working under an expert	12 months in the FPB, CID, W.B.
(c)	Independent work	12 months in the third and last year the candidate shall have to undergo the independent work alongwith practical training in the FPB, CID, W.B.

(9) After completion of 3 (three) years of satisfactory service in FPB, CID, W.B. every candidate shall have to pass the All India Board Examination of Finger Print Expert conducted by the CFPB, Government of India, New Delhi, so as to be declared as a Finger Print Expert.

(10) Confirmation :

(a) A candidate will be confirmed only after passing the All India Board Examination for Finger Print Expert conducted by CFPB, Government of India, New Delhi.

(b) A candidate is entitled to restore increments that fall due during the prescribed period of probation after passing the All India Board Examination of Finger Print Expert conducted by CFPB, Government of India, New Delhi.

(c) A candidate is not entitled to restore any increment after the expiry of period of probation unless and until the candidate is confirmed.

(d) There shall be no limit of number of attempts for appearing the All India Board Examination conducted by CFPB, Government of India, New Delhi.

(11) Saving :

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules the persons appointed on regular basis or substantively to the post covered under these rules prior to coming into force of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules.

(12) Syllabus for examination for the Recruitment of Junior Civilian Finger Print Expert in the Finger Print Bureau, CID, West Bengal is furnished below :

(a) Syllabus for written examination :

There would be only one paper for 2:30 hours duration which will be divided in the following subject. The written test will be of objective type and comprise 200 marks. The marks for each subject is indicated against each.
