The above posts were created in terms of G.O. No. 3469-PL dated 13/10/2015. With reference to above and in the cited subject the undersigned is directed to say that the matter was consulted with the Finance Department and vide note dated 07/12/2017 in the Secretariat File No. PB/4P-08/13, the Finance Department has opined that "It transpires from the Cabinet Memo that 30 (thirty) regular posts of different categories were created for new P.S. at Bhimpur in Nadia district. Since, the posts in question are regular in nature, retention is not required in this regard."

2. Accordingly, the matter was considered in this department. The undersigned is directed to say that the Governor is pleased to declare the posts of 04 (four) Sub-Inspector, 01 (one) Lady S.I., 04 (four) Asstt. Sub-Inspector, 01 (one) Lady Asstt. S.I., 15 (fifteen) Constables, 03 (three) Lady Constables, 01 (one) Wireless Operator and 01 (one) Driver in different categories in West Bengal Police for manning of the newly created Bhimpur Police Station in the District of Nadia as permanent with effect from 11/02/2017.

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In terms of this Department's Notification No. 613-PL dated 21/02/2018 read with Notification No. 612-PL dated 21/02/2018 a new Police Station at Rajapur in the district of Howrah (Rural) has been created in bifurcation of the existing Uluberia Police Station in that district.

Sub. : Proposal for setting up of three Rapid Action Force (RAF) Battalions within West Bengal Police located at Durgapur, Paschim Bardhaman; Dabgram, Siliguri and Barrackpore with the creation of total 3021 (three thousand twenty one) posts [1007 (one thousand seven) posts for each of three battalions] in different categories under the West Bengal Police and engagement of total 90 (ninety) Karmabandhu [30 (thirty) Karmabandhu for each of three Battalions] on part time basis.

Ref. : W.B.P.D.'s Memo. No. 1749 ORG/Org-253/2017 dt. 01/12/2017 and No. 371-ORG/Org-253/2017 dt. 09/03/2018.

The Proposal for setting up of three Rapid Action Force (RAF) Battalions within West Bengal Police located at Durgapur, Paschim Bardhaman; Dabgram, Siliguri and Barrackpore with the creation of total 3021 (three thousand twenty one) posts [1007 (one thousand seven) posts for each of three Battalions] in different categories under the West Bengal Police and engagement of total 90 (ninety) Karmabandhu [30 (thirty) Karmabandhu for each of three Battalions] on part time basis was under active consideration of the Government for some time past.

After detailed examination of the matter, it has been decided to accord necessary Government Approval to the proposal.

The undersigned is now directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to approve the following:-

- (i) Creation of 3 (three) RAF battalions within West Bengal Police to be located at (a) Durgapur, Paschim Bardhaman; (b) Dabgram, Siliguri and (c) Barrackpore.
- (ii) Creation of total 3021 (three thousand twenty one) posts @ 1007 posts (in 25 categories) for each Battalion as detailed below:-

- (iii) Engagement of 30 Karmabandhu on part-time basis for each Battalion @ Rs. 3000/- p.m. to be paid out of Contingency.

In regard to filling up of posts, it may be noted that 670 posts of Constable, 39 posts of S.I.(AB) and 04 posts of S.I.(UB) required for each Battalion shall be counted against the total vacancies of 25722 Constable and 2285 Sub-Inspector. Approval has since been given for filling up of 5300 posts of Constable and 800 posts of Sub-Inspector. Approval for filling up of 2010 posts of Constable (670 x 3) and 117 posts of S.I.(AB) (39 x 3) and 12 posts of S.I.(UB) (4 x 3) as per extant Recruitment Rules may be taken from this Department in due course.

The charge is debitible to the appropriate Head of Account of the State Police Budget.

The Governor is pleased to direct further that no recruitment against any vacancy in the existing Indian Reserve Battalions is made hence forth.

This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department – vide – their u/o no. Group P2/2017-2018/1097 dated 22/02/2018 and approval of the Cabinet – vide – no. 855 dated 23/03/2018.
