NOTIFICATION

Instituting Chief Minister's Bravery Award for recognising the outstanding act of courage by any Civilian as well as Police Personnel has been under active consideration of the Government for some time past. After careful consideration of all aspects associated with the issue, they Governor has now been pleased to accord approval for instituting Chief Minister's Bravery Award to honour individual or collective acts of most conspicuous bravery among the civilians and police personnel (both Kolkata Police & West Bengal Police) by issuing a Certificate / Scroll and a cash prize of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) only each.

A committee comprising of the following officers shall be constituted for screening and selection of suitable nominees for Chief Minister's Bravery Award :-

1. Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal,
Home & Hill Affairs Department
2. ADG & IGP, Administration, West Bengal : Chairman
3. IGP, Headquarters, West Bengal : Member-Convenor
4. Deputy Inspector General of Police, Headquarters, West Bengal. : Member
5. One officer of the rank of Additional Commissioner of Police, Kolkata : Member

No quota will be fixed for the number of awards to be given annually, It shall be the discretion of the State Government of finalize the nominations each year depending on the merit of each case.

The charge towards the scheme will be met from the grant under the head of account "2055 – Police – 00 – 001 – Director & Administration – NP – 002 – District Police (HQ) – V – 50 – Other Charges" in the Budget.

It has been decided by the Government of West Bengal that all buildings and installations of West Bengal Police which have been hitherto maintained by PWD will be transferred to the books of the West Bengal Police Housing & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd.
