With reference to your Memo. No. 381/ORG dated 12.03.2018 on the above noted subject I am directed to say that Governor has been pleased to approve the proposal for shifting of Office-Cum-residence of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Crime) Baruipur to a hired accommodation @ monthly rent of Rs. 16,603/- + Rs. 15,932/- total Rs. 32,535/- (thirty two thousand five hundred and thirty five only).
