Sub : Blacklisting M/s Creaty Teleinfra Pvt. Ltd., 3, C.R. Avenue, Bharat Bhawan, Kolkata - 700072 in connection with non-supply of Iron Cot with Mosquito Pole to West Bengal Police during the year 2017-2018.

Ref : Your letter Ref. Nos. CTPL/WBPD/Cloth/11/2018-19, dtd. 07.05.18 & this office memo no. 1014-EQ/CL DTD. 07.08.18.

With reference to your letter on the subject quoted above, following are mentioned :-

- i) You have offered the tender against NIT No. WBPD/CLOTHING/NIT - 01/2017-18, dtd. 13.07.17 floated by Police Head Quarter, West Bengal for various items including the item "Iron Cot with Mosquito Pole".
- ii) You have technically qualified and ranked as L-1 bidder for the item quoting lowest rate i.e. Rs.2,794.24/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred ninety four and paisa twenty four) only including GST and all other taxes per pc.
- iii) The sample of the item i.e. " Iron Cot with Mosquito Pole", supplied by you as per this specifications has been accepted by the Central Clothing Committee.
- iv) You have entered on agreement for supply of 6000 pcs. of Iron Cots with Mosquito Poles to West Bengal Police at the L-1 rate within 31.12.17 as per terms and condition laid down in the NIT vide this office memo no. 1280-EQ/CL dtd.03.11.17.
- v) After receiving the agreement form duly filled in from your end vide your letter Ref. no. CTPL/WBPD/CLOTH/98/2017-18, dtd. 13.11.17, a firm order for supply 6000 pcs. of Iron Cots with Mosquito Poles to the Central Clothing Stores, M.P. Udyan, Barrackpore according to this office specifications and your sample accepted for the year 2017-18 within office hours as per accepted rate of Rs.2,794.24/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred ninety four and pairs twenty four) only including GST per pc as per time frame scheduled within 31.12.17, was issued vide this office memo no. 1383-EQ/CL, dtd.17.11.17.
- vi) As per your request vide letter Ref. no. CTPL/WBPD/CLOGIG/104/2017-18, dtd.30.11.17, delivery period of the said 6000 pcs. of "Iron Cot with Mosquito Pole" was extended up to 31.03.18 vide this office memo no. 1606/1(2)-EQ/CL, dtd.26.12.17.
- vii) Your prayer for enhancement of cost of Rs.400/- per pc against each of the said item vide your letter Ref. no. CTPL/WBPD/Cloth/134/2017-18, dtd. 24.01.18 has been considered and rejected according to the tender rule and you were asked to supply the item in full quantity positively as per accepted rate of Rs.2,794.24/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred ninety four and paisa twenty four) only including GST per pc within the time schedule and this specifications and as per your sample accepted for the year 2017-18 within the extended period of time i.e. 31.03.18 vide this office memo no. 206-EQ/CL, dtd. 15.02.18.

- viii) Again as per your prayer Ref. No. CTPL/WBPD/CLOTHING/155/2017-18, Dtd.19.02.18, a "**Notice**" was issued vide this office memo no. 314-EQ/CL dtd. 09.03.18 asking for supply the item in full quantity positively as per accepted rate of Rs.2,794.24/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred ninety four and paisa twenty four) only including GST per pc within the time schedule and this specifications and as per your sample accepted for the year 2017-18 within the extended period of time i.e. 31.03.18 failure of which necessary action against your Firm will be taken as per NIT vide this office memo no. 206-EQ/CL, dtd 15.02.18.
- ix) You had supplied only 150(one hundred fifty) pieces of Iron Cots with mosquito pole to the Central Clothing Stores, Barrackpore vide challan no. CTPL /WBPD /CLOTH / CH /101 / 2017-18, dtd 08.03.18, but those were rejected totally by the concerned committee in the Central Clothing Stores, Barrackpore. After that not a single piece of the item were supplied by you within the extended period of time [31.03.18].
- x) Your prayers ref. no. CTPL/WBPD/CLOTH/172/2017-18, dtd 19.03.18 & CTPL / WBPD / CLOTH/11/2018-19, dtd 07.05.18 were considered but rejected by the department.
- xi) Finally the period of the tender NIT No. WBPD/CLOTHING/NIT-01/2017-18 DTD 13.07.17 is already over as the financial year 2017-18 is already completed.
- xii) Your failure to supply of the Iron Cot with mosquito pole after acceptance of the rate offered by you and to execute agreement of contract not only violated the terms and conditions of the Tender Notice But also dislocation in smooth supply of the said essential item of West Bengal Police and considerable financial loss to Government.
- xiii) You have violated the terms and conditions of the contract as agreed by you in your tender offer and tried to cheat the department although frequent extension have been granted in delivery period. the non-execution of supplies has also effected the annual budget of the Department. More so the Police Head Quarter could not meet the requirement of the Department in time.
- xiv) A show-cause notice was issued to you under this office memo no. 1014-EQ/CL datd 07.08.18 asking explanation for such lapses committed by you within 15(fifteen) days and also to let this office know why your Firm will not be blacklisted as per terms & conditions laid down in the NIT.
- xv) In reply to the show-cause notice, the explanation given by you vide your letter no. CTPL/WBPD/Cloth/11/2018-19, dated 07.05.18 was found not satisfactory and convincing as per terms of tender norms prescribed by the Finance Department.

In view of the above facts and prejudice, your Firm is hereby blacklisted for a period of 5(five) years from the date of issue of this letter and the orders placed vide this office memo nos. 1383-EQ/CL, dtd 17.11.17; 1606-EQ/CL, dtd 26.12.17 & 206-EQ/CL, dtd 15.02.18 are hereby cancelled.
