Sub : Creation of 52 (fifty two) posts of different categories in West Bengal Police and engagement or 01 (one) part-time karmabandhu for manning Narendrapur Police Station in South 24-Parganas district.

In terms of this Department's Notification No. 397-PL dated 07.02.2019 read with Notification No. 396-PL dated 07.02.2019 issued in supersession of this Department's Notification No. 1549-PL dated 23.05.2018 read with Notification No. 1548-PL dated 23.05.2018 a new Police Station at Narendrapur in the district of South 24-Parganas has been created in bifurcation of the existing Sonarpur Police Station in that district.

2) Now, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to accord sanction to the creation of 52 (fifty two) regular posts of different categories under West Bengal Police on the usual rates of pay and allowances for manning said Narendrapur Police Station, as detailed hereunder :-

- 3) The Governor is also pleased to allow the engagement of one (1) Karmabandhu (Part-time sweeper) at a consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs. 3000/- (three thousand) only for the said Police Station to be paid out of contingency, vide Finance Department's Memo. No. 7284-F(P2) dated 27.11.2017.
- 4) The posts referred in sl. 2 above may be filled up on observance of extant recruitment rules.
- 5) The charge is debitable to the appropriate Head of Account in the State Police Budget.
- 6) This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their **U.O. No. Gr.P2/2017-2018/0705 dated 31.10.2017 and approval of the Cabinet held on 19.12.2017.**
- 7) The Principal Accountant General, West Bengal is being informed.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, Shri Dipendra Tamang, Inspector of Police (Un-armed Branch) was not considered by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal for promotion to the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) since his caste category was inadvertently mentioned as 'General' in place of 'ST'. The matter of such inadvertent mistake was then referred to the Public Service Commission, West Bengal and the Commission had advised to create a Supernumerary post of Deputy Superintendent of Police to accommodate Shri Tamang in the said promotional post.

WHEREAS, the matter of according promotion to Shri Dipendra Tamang, Inspector of Police (Un-armed Branch) to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) under the West Bengal Police Directorate w.e.f. 29.12.2017 has been under active consideration of the state Government in the Home & Hill Affairs Department since sometime past as he was considered eligible for promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) with effect from the above mentioned date. As no vacancy for the purpose had been found in existence from 29.12.2017 (i.e. on the date on which his promotion was due) but from 01.06.2019, the proposal for creation of a Supernumerary post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) from 29.12.2017 to 31.05.2019 to give effect of the promotion as stated above was considered by this department.

WHEREAS, the matter had been sent to the Finance Department for obtaining necessary approval for creation of 1 (one) Supernumerary post in the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) in West Bengal Police Directorate from 29.12.2017 to 31.05.2019 for awarding promotion to Shri Dipendra Tamang, Inspector of Police (Un-armed Branch) and the Finance Department, vide their U.O. No. Group P2/2019-2020/0065 dated 29.05.2019, considering the urgency and gravity of the matter, agreed to create 1 (one) Supernumerary post in the rank of Dy. Superintendent of Police (UB) from 29.12.2017 to 31.05.2019 for awarding promotion to Shri Dipendra Tamang, Inspector of Police (UB) subject to approval of the Cabinet.

WHEREAS, the proposal for creation of the aforesaid post was approved by the Cabinet vide Cabinet Decision No. 1326 dated 03.07.2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor is pleased hereby to create a Supernumerary post in the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Un-armed Branch) in the West Bengal Police Directorate from 29.12.2017 to 31.05.2019 for awarding promotion to Shri Dipendra Tamang, Inspector of Police (Un-armed Branch) in order to giving effect of promotion in favour of Shri Dipendra Tamang, i.e. from the post of Inspector of Police (Un-armed Branch) to Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Un-armed Branch) w.e.f. 29.12.2017.

This notification issues with the concurrence of Finance Department (Audit), vide U.O. No. Group P2/2019-2020/0065 dated 29.05.2019,

The charges in this respect will be debited to the appropriate Head of Account.
