Sub : Proposal for creation of New town Eco Park Police Station and Technocity Police Station by trifurcation of existing New Town Police Station under Bidhannagar Police Commissionerate with the creation of 126 (one hundred twenty six) new posts in different categories under the West Bengal Police and engagement of 01(one) part time Karmabandhu for each new Police Station ie. in total 252 (two hundred fifty two) posts and 2(two) part time Karmabandhus.

In terms of this Department's Notification No. 2941-PL dated 20/09/2019, No. 2942-PL dated 20/09/2019 and No. 2943-PL dated 20/09/2019 New Town Eco Park Police Station and Technocity Police Station have been created by trifurcation of existing New Town Police Station under Bidhannagar Police Commissionerate.

2) Now, the undersigned is directed to say that creation of man power for manning the new Police Station at New Town Eco Park and Technocity were under active consideration of the Government for some time past. After careful consideration of the matter the governor has been pleased to accord sanction to the creation of 126 (one hundred twenty six) new posts for each new Police Station totalling 252 (two hundred fifty two) regular posts in different categories under the West Bengal Police on the usual rate of pay and allowances for manning the new Police Stations at New town Eco Park and Technocity, as detailed hereunder:-

3) Total number of sanctioned posts for 2(two) P.S.s as per above is, therefore, 252. Two part-time Karmabandhu may also be engaged at a consolidated remuneration of Rs.3000/- per month for each part-time Karmabandhu to be paid out of contingency for the 2(two) newly created P.S.s in question.

4) The posts as mentioned in para 2 above may be filled up on observance of extant recruitment rules.

5) The charge is debitible to the appropriate Head of Account in the Sate Police Budget.
