The following points were put up for decision of the Board:-

**i) To examine the Result of the Final Examination of 18-Dy.SsP(U/T) of Batch No. 68/2019.**

- 18-Dy SsP(U/T) joined SVSPA, Barrackpore for undergoing their Basic Training on and after 01.04.2019 in Batch No. 68/2019.
- DIG, Training/Principal, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore has sent, the Result Sheet of Final Examination of 18-Dy SsP (U/T) of Batch No. 68/2019 & vide Memo No. SVSPA/Exam Cell / Dy. SP(U/T) / 01(IX)/2010-3499 dated 18/12/2019.
- Out of which 01-Dy.SP(U/T) namely Shri Sudipta roy has joined SVSPA, Barrackpore for undergoing his Basic Training on 08.06.2019 in Batch No. 68/2019 and he is declared as 'detained' vide Academy Order No. 1113 dated 25.11.19 for absenting himself from training curriculum for a period more than 15% of the prescribed training duration because of his late joining.
- 17-Dy.SsP (U/T) appeared in the final examinations of both indoor and outdoor subjects.
- 17-Dy.SsP(U/T) completely passed in the both indoor and outdoor subjects.(list enclosed).
- The result of the same is placed before tha 'Board of Control for Training' for approval.

**ii) Misc Point :**

**a) Internal Assessment:** As per approved syllabus 50 marks for Indoor & 50 marks for Outdoor training has been allotted for Internal Assessment of trainee officers to be given by DIG, Training/Principal, SVSPA, Barrackpor. According to the new Notification of Govt. of West Bengal, Home & Hill Affairs Department, Police Service Cell, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata Vide No. 1241-PS. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2016 Dt. 08.06.2018, the inter se seniority of the members of West Bengal Police Service appointed on the basis of the examination held by the P.S.C., shall be determined on the basis of the aggregate of (i) Total marks obtained in W.B. Civil Service(Exe.) etc. Examination and (ii) total marks out of 200 marks in the induction Training comprising (a) Basic Training at SVSPA, (140 marks) (b) District Practical Training and attachments (40 marks) (c) Assessment of DIG(Trg.)-Cum-Principal, SVSPA, Barrackpore (20 marks).

As per approved syllabus 100 marks allotted for Internal Assessment on Indoor and Outdoor training. Considering the overriding effects of the latest GO, earlier system of Internal Assessment has become redundant & discriminatory as new GO categorically mentions about the Marking System.

**On discussion the Board resolved the following decision :-**

- 1) The Board approved the Result of 17-Dy.SsP(U/T) who appeared in final examination both Indoor and outdoor subjects and passed in all subjects. They are declared as "**Passed**" and will undergo District Practical Training and Attachment tentatively from 18.01.20 as per revised Compendium of Instructions after Passing Out Parade on 04.01.20 & Field Training at Gangasagar Mela.

- 2) It has been decided that Shri Sudipta Roy, Dy.SP (U/T) who is detained due to above 15% of absence in training curriculum, will have to appear in supplementary final examination. He will be detained for one month at SVSPA, Barrackpore after the date of passing out of the batch. DIG, Training/Principal, SVSPA, Barrackpore will arrange the supplementary final examination. After qualifying supplementary final examination he will undergo District Practical Training and Attachment accordingly.
- 3) Considering the overriding effects of the latest GO in which 140 pro rata marks are allotted for Indoor (80) and Outdoor (60) examinations based on their performance in the Indoor & Outdoor subjects. Hence, the old system of Internal Assessment is no longer required because it is redundant & supererogatory. Henceforth, total marks to be allotted for final examination on Indoor subjects will be 650 and on Outdoor subjects will be 600.
- 4) As per newly framed and notified rules regulating inter se seniority of the members of West Bengal Police Service conveyed vide Notification No. 1241-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2016 dated 17/07/2018 published at Kolkata Gazette on 03.07.2018 the merit list of basic training of Dy.SP(U/T) at SVSPA, Barrackpore & District Practical Training and attachment will be compiled by the DIGP, training/Principal, SVSPA, W.B., Barrackpore and place before BOC for Training for approval and onward transmission to the Govt. for fixation of inter se seniority through West Bengal Police Directorate.
