The undersigned is directed to state that the Governor has been pleased to accord administrative approval for Enhancement of the Police Cost of both the West Bengal Police and the Kolkata Police, with effect from 01.01.2020, to the private individual/organisation/Bank etc. consequent upon revision of pay etc. of Police under Revision of Pay and Allowances, 2019, in accordance with the following guidelines :

1)	Assistant Commissioner	Rs. 4,243/- per shift of 6 hrs.
2)	Inspector	Rs. 3,395/- per shift of 6 hrs.
3)	Sub-Inspector	Rs. 2,825/- per shift of 6 hrs.
4)	Assistant Sub-Inspector	Rs. 2,229/- per shift of 6 hrs.
5)	Sepoy/Constables	Rs. 1,932/- per shift of 6 hrs.

AND

Vehicle (RFS-Radio Flying Squad) for cash escort - Rs. 1,000/- per hour.

2. The rate per shift in respect of the Police hire charges shall be (the average basic pay of the post + D.A. (Prevailing rates) + 90% of the average basic pay) divided by 30.

3. 90% of average basic pay shall be considered for H.R.A. plus one month's pay for deprivation of holidays plus Ration. Allowances plus T.A./D.A. plus other Miscellaneous allowances as applicable.

4. Average Basic Pay means the average basic pay of the basic grade posts only. Average Basic Pay in respect of different posts are as follows :
