2) Now, the under signed is, therefore, directed to say that the Governor, after careful consideration of the matter has been pleased to agree for engagement of 14 (fourteen) Karmabandhu on part-time basis at a consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs.3000/- (three thousand) only for newly created STF West Bengal and its Branch Office.

(a) All winners and runners up in the Sports Cup for every year with effect from the Financial Year 2016-17 and onwards in respect of (i) Jungle Mahal Cup (ii) Himal-Tarai-Dooars Sports Festival and (iii) Sundarban Cup as civic volunteers of special category from sports and placed in common list of civic volunteers

(b) All winners and runners up newly introduced (i) Saikat Cup (ii) Cooch Behar Cup (iii) Khet-Nodi Utsav (iv) Jaltarang Sports Festival & (v) Rangamati Sports Utsav with effect from the Financial Year 2018-19 and onwards as 'civic volunteers of special category from sports and placed in common list of civic Volunteers'.

2) The Governor is also pleased to state that (i) the age of the candidates in respect of the above mentioned 08(eight) sports events shall not be less than 18 years. (ii) the educational qualification of the candidates will be class VIII pass and the candidates having lower qualification (not Class VII pass) are also eligible for enrolment subject to the condition that they will acquire prescribed qualification later on.

3) The strength of Civic Volunteers will not exceed the existing total sanctioned strength for West Bengal Police.
