**Sub : Retention of temporary post of 02 part-time cleaners in the office of I.B., West Bengal.
Ref : Your office memo no. 76/ORG dated 15.01.2020.**

1. Retention of the above posts was approved upto 31.03.2020 in terms of this Deptt.'s G.O. No. 1404-PL dtd. 03.06.2019. The matter was consulted with the Finance Department and vide their note dated 09.06.2016 in the Secretariat File No. PB/3P-41/04(Pt), the Finance Department has opined that "Part-time sweepers are engaged not against post. So, question of retention of post does not arise. Such part-time workers are paid out of Contingencies. If the situation demands the Adman Department may allow to continuing such part-time engagement."
2. Accordingly, the matter was considered in this department. The undersigned is directed to say that the Governor is pleased to allow continuation of the engagement in the temporary posts of 02(two) Part-time Cleaners in the office of I.B. West Bengal for a further period of 01 (one) year with **effect from 01.04.2020** on the existing terms and conditions and approved rates remuneration for such posts.
3. The charge will initially be met from the Contingency Fund.

**Sub : Retention of temporary 20 (twenty) Sweepers (Karmabandhu) for the office of SAP, 12th Bn.,

Sanction was accorded in terms of G.O. No. 3208-PL/PB/3P-17/16 dated 04-08-2017 for engagement of 20 (twenty) Sweepers of SAP 12th Bn, Dabgram, Jalpaiguri on purely temporary basis with approved consolidated remuneration to be paid from contingency. The above posts were retained for one (01) year upto 31.10.2019 in terms of G.O. No. 3581-PL dt. 07.12.2018. But the reason for creating these posts is still exist.

2. The Finance Department opined that “The Administrative Department may be intimated that in term of F.D. Memo No. 1885-F(P) dated 02.03.2012, they are competent enough to extend the tenure of 20 (twenty) part-time sweepers of SAP 12th Battalion, Dabagram, Jalpaiguri as these are not against any sanctioned post.”

3. Accordingly, the matter was considered in this department. The undersigned is now directed to allow extension of such tenure in respect of the said 20 (twenty) Part-time Sweepers (Karmabandhu) of SAP 12th Bn, Dabgram, Jalpaiguri for a further period of 01 (one) year with effect from 01-11-2019 under the same terms and conditions as laid down in the aforesaid G.O. and with approved extant consolidated remuneration to be paid from contingency.
