WHEREAS vide order no. 210-PL dated 15.01.2010, Jhargram Police district was created by dividing the Paschim Medinipur District with jurisdiction over nine Police stations mentioned therein (hereafter referred to as the said notification);

AND WHEREAS subsequently, Lalgarth Police Station was taken out of Jhargram Police District vide No. 1377-PL dated 07.04.2010 issued by the Home (Police) Department;

AND WHEREAS it has been considered necessary to exclude the Lalgarth Police Station including the area and boundary there from the Paschim Medinipur Police District and to include the same to the jurisdiction of Jhargram Police District to make the area of the Jhargram Police District co-terminus with the Jhargram District created vide Notification No. 79/AR/0/2R-1/2011 dated 20.03.2017 issued by the Personnel & Administrative Reforms and e-Governance Department.

NOW THEREFORE, In exercise of power conferred by section 2 of the Police Act, 1861 (5 of 1861), read with section 2 of the Bengal Police Act, 1869 (Ben Act VII of 1869), and in partial modification of the said notification, the Governor is pleased hereby to exclude the Lalgarth Police Station and the area and boundary there from the Paschim Medinipur Police District and to include the same to the jurisdiction of the existing Jhargram Police District;

The territorial jurisdiction of Jhargram Police District shall consist of the areas and boundaries of Nine (9) Police Stations namely Jhargram Police Station, Jamboni Police Station, Sankrail Police Station, Gopiballabypur Police Station, Nayagram Police Station, Belpahari Police Station, Binpur Police Station, Belaberia Police Station and Lalgarth Police Station and the said police stations shall form part of the said Jhargram Police District.

Asansol-Durgapur Police District was created vide Notification No. 3611-PL dated 26.08.2011 and the office of the Superintendent of Police, Asansol-Durgapur Police District was re-designated as office of the Commissioner of Police, Asansol-Durgapur vide Notification No. 3613-PL dated 26.08.2011.

2. As it was felt necessary to re-organise the jurisdiction of Asansol-Durgapur Police District (Asansol-Durgapur Police Commissionerate), Notification in respect of inclusion of two Police Stations namely Kanksa Police Station and Buddud Police Station to the jurisdiction of Asansol-Durgapur Police District has been issued vide No. 1492-PL dated 07.04.2017 and published in the Official Gazette on 07.04.2017. The Notification is in force w.e.f. 07.04.2017. Sanction has also been accorded for creation of one post of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kanksa vide Order No. 668-P.S. Cell dated 07.04.2017.

3. WHEREAS vide Notification No. 3611-PL dated 26.08.2011 issued by the Home (Police) Department, Asansol-Durgapur Police District and Burdwan Police District were created by dividing the existing Burdwan Police District with their respective territorial jurisdictions (hereinafter referred to as the said notification);

AND WHEREAS, vide Notification No. 3612-PL dated 26.08.2011, the areas of the Asansol-Durgapur Police District was declared as a Metropolitan area and vide Notification No. 3613-PL dated 26.08.2011, the office of the Superintendent of Police, Asansol-Durgapur Police District was re-designed as office of the Commissioner of Police, Asansol-Durgapur and the Commissioner of Police was vested with the powers and authorities under the Police Act 1861 or under any other Act;

Now, in exercise of power conferred by section 2 of the Police Act, 1861 (5 of 1861), read with section 2 of the Bengal Police Act, 1869 (Ben. Act VII of 1869) and in partial modification of the said Notification, the Governor is pleased hereby to exclude the Kanksa Police Station and the areas and boundaries therein; and the Budbud Police Station and the areas and boundaries there from the existing Burdwan Police District and to include the same to the jurisdiction of the existing Asansol-Durgapur Police District.

THEREFORE, the territorial jurisdiction of Asansol-Durgapur Police District for the purpose of Police Act, 1861, shall extend to the areas and boundaries of 17 (seventeen) Police stations namely Asansol (South) Police Station, Asansol (North) Police Station, Raniganj Police Station, Jamuria Police Station, Hirapur Police Station, Baraboni Police Station, Kulti Police Station, Salanpur Police Station, Chittaranjan Police Station, Andal Police Station Faridpur Police Station, Pandabeswar Police Station, Durgapur Police Station, New Township Police Station, Coke-Oven Police Station, Kanksa Police Station and Budbud Police Station and the said Police Stations shall form part of the Asansol-Durgapur Police district.

2. This notification shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
