The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord sanction to the creation of 1107 nos. of different posts with corresponding Pay band, band pay at entry point with Grade pay, as shown at annexure-I along with financial implication amounting Rs. 114,86,06,952/- (one hundred fourteen crore eighty six lacsix thousand nine hundred & fifty two) as liability of State Govt. after adjusting the reimbursement from central Government to incur the total cost of Manpower during 1st year to 9th year.

- 2) the undersigned is further directed by order of the Governor to say that these sanctioned posts should be filled up on observance of extant recruitment rules. Page 1 of 33
- 3) The re-imbursement claim from Central Government should be preferred time to time as per Annexure-II to incur the total cost of Manpower during 1st year to 9th year.
- 4) The charge for State liability in this respect will be met from the grant under the head of A/C"2055-Police-00-109-Dist.Police – NP-Non Plan-001 West Bengal Police" under Demand No. 27, in the State Police Budget.
- 5) This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance (Audit) Department, Vide their U.O.No. Group-P2/2014-15/2226 dated 16.09.2014 and also with the approval of the Cabinet in its meeting held on 12.12.14 vide Communication no.-2008 dt.17.12.14 of the Joint Secretary, Cabinet Secretariat.
- 6) The Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal and the Principal Account General(Audit), West Bengal has been informed.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE 'BOARD OF CONTROL FOR TRAINING' HELD ON 30-01-2015
AT 15-30 HOURS AT THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF DG & IGP, TRAINING, WEST BENGAL, POLICE
RECORDS BHAWAN, SALT LAKE CITY, KOLKATA - 91.

Shri A. K. Maliwal, IPS, Director General & Inspector General of Police, Training, West Bengal presided over the meeting.

Following members of the 'Board of Control for Training' attended the meeting -

1. **Shri S. Chander**, IPS, ADG (Establishment), WB holding Addl. Charge of IGP (Headquarters), WB.
2. **Shri Tripurari**, IPS, DIG, Training, WB and holding Addl. Charge of IGP (Headquarters), WB.
3. **Shri T. Basu**, IPS, DIG, Training-cum-Principal, SVSPA, BKP, WB.
4. **Shri M.K. Das**, IPS, DIG (Administration), West Bengal.
5. **Shri S.K. Paul**, IAS, Commissioner, Home Department, Government of West Bengal.
6. **Shri Haider Ali**, Joint Controller of Examination, Calcutta University, Representative of Calcutta University as special Invitee for this Meeting.

Shri R. K. Gupta, IPS, Addl. Director General & Inspector General of Police (Administration), WB also attended the meeting on special request by DG & IGP, Training, West Bengal.

Discussion on the following items of Agenda / Additional Agenda was held in the meeting and decision taken as mentioned below.

I. Handbook on Investigation for ASIs -

It was informed to the members that DG & IGP, W.B. had desired that Investigation Manual / Hand Book for ASIs of West Bengal Police should be prepared by the Training Branch / SVSPA, Barrackpore. He also desired that the proposed Investigation Manual should provide required contents along with Check Points for each chapter and should also be concise so as to make it User Friendly. Keeping in view the above, a Task Group was set-up at SVSPA, Barrackpore which in the initial phase also included officer deputed by CID, West Bengal. DGP, Training, stated that Working for over six months on several drafts, the present draft as placed before the members appears to satisfy the objectives set by the DG & IGP, W.B.

DIG, Training, WB Cum Principal SVSPA explained the details of this final draft. Suggestion were made by ADG(Adm.) WB stating that Bullet Points on investigation of specified cases should be given. ADG(Estt.) WB suggested that CIs / ICs should be directed to monitor the understanding of the contents of this manual by regular briefing to the ASIs. It was informed that check points given at the end of each chapter are in the form of bullet points and direction to CIs / ICs may be issued by WBPD.

It was also suggested by the members that each Police Station should be given at least two hard copies and a hard copy each should be given to the offices of the Supervisory Officers. Along with this a soft copy should be given to every district / Commissionerate. Accordingly it was decided that 1000 copies (hard copy) would be required for distribution as above. Members also decided to title this as Hand Book on Investigation for ASIs of WBP. It was also decided that printing of the hard copy will be done at Government Printing Press for which money will be allotted. DIG Training cum Principal SVSPA will please take necessary follow of action regarding printing of the hand book.

II. Handbook on Investigation for SIs -

It was informed to the members that DG & IGP, W.B. had also desired that Investigation Manual / Hand Book for SIs of West Bengal Police should be prepared by the Training Branch / SVSPA, Barrackpore. He also desired that the proposed Investigation Manual should provide required contents along with Check Points for each chapter and should also be concise so as to make it user friendly. Keeping in view the above, a separate Task Group was set-up at SVSPA, Barrackpore which in the initial phase also included officer deputed by CID, West Bengal. DGP, Training, stated that Working for over six months on several drafts, the present draft as placed before the members appears to satisfy the objectives set by the DG & IGP, W.B.

DIG, Training, WB Cum Principal SVSPA explained the details of this final draft.

It was suggested by the members that each Police Station should be given at least two hard copies and a hard copy each should be given to the offices of the Supervisory Officers. Along with this a soft copy should be given to every district / Commissionerate. Accordingly it was decided that 1000 copies (hard copy) would be required for distribution as above. Members also decided to title this as Hand Book on Investigation for SIs of WBP. It was also decided that printing of the hard copy will be done at Government Printing Press for which money will be allotted. DIG Training cum Principal SVSPA will please take necessary follow of action regarding printing of the hand book.

III. Proposed in-service Training Manual -

It was informed to the members that DG & IGP, WB desired that in-service training in West Bengal Police needs to be streamlined and systematized as it is noticed that different district / Commissionerates are presently conducting In-Service Training for Courses / Topics

with duration and frequency which differ from District to District / Commissionerate. He therefore desired that Training Branch should prepare In-Service Training Manual for unarmed branch of West Bengal Police which should standardize the In-Service Training activity.

DGP, Training, WB stated that preparation of In-Service Training Manual started from August 2014 involving interactions / inputs from various stake holders. The preparation is presently in the final stage. Based on the interactions / inputs, courses / topics and duration have been finalized. Model / Sample course schedule / contents are now being prepared with the help of assigned / specialized Branch / Unit of West Bengal Police. After receipt of the above, the draft of the proposed In-Service Training Manual will be prepared.

Members of the Board accepted the broad outlines of the proposed In-Service Training Manual as explained by DGP, Training, WB. and agreed that the work should be carried on expeditiously so that the proposed In-Service Training Manual is ready.

IV. Training cost Estimates -

It was informed to the members that Operational Guidelines for the working of the Board of Control for Training include that training cost estimates should be prepared. Such training cost estimates after due approval of 'The Board' be sent to the competent authority for decision regarding realization of the Training Cost from Police Personnel who resign from service within the training period / specified period of the service. Therefore the work on estimating the training cost was undertaken by the Working Group of SVSPA, Barrackpore.

The working note of the Training Cost estimates was explained to the members by DIG, Training Cum Principal, SVSPA. He stated that the present order of the competent authority dates back to 1958 and that too refers to realization of the prescribed training cost (1958 prices / value) from Police Personnel of other States who undergo training. During discussion members unanimously agreed that Training Cost should be recovered from Police Personnel who resign during training / specified period. They however observed that it needs to be examined whether recovery of Training Cost would require commensurate provision in the Recruitment Rules / Appointment Letter etc.

Further, ADG (Estt.) WB offered that he would obtain details relating to Training Cost Calculation / Estimation from CISF which may be helpful in working out proposed estimation of the Training Cost.

It was agreed that matter requires further examination and there after a suitable proposal should be sent to the competent authority. DIG Training cum Principal, SVSPA will please follow up accordingly.

V. Release of Police Training Manual 2014 -

DGP, Training, WB informed to the members that Police Training Manual 2014 which was accepted by the Board in its meeting dated 12th June, 2014 and approved by the DG & IGP,

WB was printed in the Government Printing Press and 300 copies of the same were received from the printing press. This Police Training Manual 2014 was released by the DG & IGP, WB on 3rd January, 2015. Some copies of the Police Training Manual were distributed on the day of the release and further distribution is in process. A copy of the Police Training Manual so released was placed before the members of 'The Board'. This effort of preparing Police Training Manual for West Bengal Police, after nearly 80 years of the last such publication (Police Training College Training Manual 1936) was once again appreciated by the members of 'The Board'.

It was decided that the Police Training Manual 2014 shall be deemed to be effective from its date of release (3rd January, 2015).

VI. Syllabus for Basic Training Course of Dy. SPs (U/T) -

It was informed to the members that the existing syllabus of the Dy. SP (U/T) was approved by the Board in May, 2010 and revision of the syllabus was necessitated. The Operational Guidelines of 'The Board' also require that Syllabus for different Training Courses should be revised as and when required. Accordingly work on revision of the Basic Training Syllabus Dy. SP (U/T) started in February, 2014 and initial drafts received from SVSPA, Barrackpore were returned with observations. Thereafter Working Group of the SVSPA, was entrusted with the responsibility of preparing the revised syllabus and the proposed Final Draft is the 4th such draft prepared by the Working Group of the SVSPA. A copy of the proposed Syllabus / Draft was already circulated to the Members before this Meeting.

Shri S.K. Paul, IAS, Commissioner Home Department, W.B. inquired whether a programme of Field Orientation during Training would be useful for Dy. SP(U/T) and also suggested if training with other State / CPOs could be introduced. ADG(Estt.) WB suggested that modules on Leadership Management, Cyber Crime etc. should be included in the Training Schedule as per syllabus.

DIG, Training, Cum Principal SVSPA explained the contents of the proposed syllabus for indoor and outdoor activity to be undergone by Dy. SP(U/T) in the institutional training (Basic Training at SVSPA, Barrackpore) and also District Practical Training Schedule. He explained the total duration, number of training days available, number of training session available, duration of each session, likely number of holidays other than 2nd Saturday and Sunday, visit to different police units, attachment at ATI Salt Lake and also subjects / papers for indoor and outdoor training with contents of the syllabus, maximum marks / pass marks, examination frequency and methodology etc. It was noticed by the members that excepting the suggestion of training with other State / CPOs (which would require MOU with such agencies after due permission of the competent authority), other Suggestions have been taken care of in the proposed syllabus.

With prior perusal of the proposed syllabus and also detailed discussion as above, members unanimously accepted the proposed syllabus. This new Syllabus will be applicable for the Basic Training of next Batch and subsequent Batches until further revision.

It was decided that final draft of the Syllabus as discussed today shall be submitted by DIG, Training Cum Principal SVSPA, Barrackpore to the office of DGP, Training, West Bengal and DG & IGP, West Bengal through DIG(Admn.) W.B. which would be taken as Master Copy of the approved Syllabus.

ADG (Admn.) WB informed the large number of vacancies in the rank of Dy. SP and pressing need to fill up the same vacancies. Referring to the discussion held at WBPD, he suggested that the district Practical Training of the present Batch may be considered by the board to be reduced to 4 months instead of 6 months as provided in the above approved syllabus. A proposed 4 months scheduled of district practical training was also placed before the members. Keeping in view the requirement of filling up the vacancies, it was decided by the Board that District Practical Training for 4 months of the Present Batch now undergoing training at SVSPA, Barrackpore is reduced to 4 months as per schedule proposed in the meeting. It was decided that reduction in duration of District Practical Training as accepted here will be only for the Present Batch.

VII. Results of Supplementary Examination of the failed Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 who could not secured pass marks in 'Swimming' in the Final Examination.

- Deputy Inspector General of Police, Training-cum-Principal, Swami Vivekananda State Police Academy, Barrackpore sent, the result of the supplementary examination of the failed Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 who could not secure pass marks in 'Swimming' in the Final Examination vide memo no-SVSPA/Exam Cell/SI (UB) /02(V)-311 dtd- 28/01/2015.
- The result of the same is placed before the 'Board for Control for Training' for approval.

DECISION -

The Board perused and approved Results of Supplementary Examination of the failed Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 in the above subject / examination and approved the result of all the 15 candidates who appeared at this supplementary examination.

Referring to the operational guidelines of 'The Board' it was decided that Cadet SI-113-Vicky Sonkar who did not appear at the above supplementary examination will be given one more chance only to appear / pass the said examination and if he fails to appear in that last and final chance or fails in the examination, he will not be given any further chance and his case will be decided as per rules of the department.

The Board also decided that, DIG, Training-cum-Principal, SVSPA, BKP will inform CP, Kolkata along with the copy of such resolution referring the decision and to ensure that necessary Training / Practice/opportunity is given to Cadet SI-113-Vicky Sonkar for the swimming and its examination. The last and final chance / supplementary examination should be held within June, 2015.

VIII. Results of Final Examination of Detained Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14.

Deputy Inspector General of Police, Training-cum-Principal, Swami Vivekananda State Police Academy, Barrackpore sent, the result of the Final Examination of detained four-Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 vide memo no-4334/CLI, SVSPAa, WB, Barrackpore dtd-09/12/2014.

- The result of the same is placed before the 'Board for Control for Training' for approval.

DECISION –

The Board perused and approved Results of Final Examination of Four-detained Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 under reference above for next course of action.

Four detained Cadet SIs (UB), KP, Batch No-61/13-14 appeared in the 1st supplementary examination on both indoor and outdoor subjects. Out of them Three-detained cadet SIs viz Cadets No-81-Saptarshi Ghosh, Cadet SI No-121-Pritam Kumar Biswas and Cadet SI-122-Kaushik Mukherjee have completely passed in both indoor and outdoor subjects while Cadet LSI-84 Shabana Khatoon Middy of KP failed in 'swimming'. For which she will have to appear in the last and final 2nd Supplementary examination in that failed subject afterwards. Kolkata Police will facilitate to learn swimming and conduct final examination of swimming of such candidate.

The Board also decided that LSI-84 Shabana Khatoon Middy of KP who failed in swimming test examination will be given one more chance only to appear in the said examination. If she does not appear or fails in the last and final supplementary examination she will not be given any further chance and her case will be decided as per rules of the department. The last and final chance / supplementary examination should be held within June, 2015.

The Board also decided that, DIG, Training-cum-Principal, SVSPA, BKP will inform CP, Kolkata along with the copy of such resolution referring the decision and to ensure that necessary Training / Practice/opportunity is given to LSI- 84 Shabana Khatoon Middy of KP for the swimming and its examination. The last and final chance / supplementary examination should be held within June, 2015.

The members of the 'Board of Control for Training' also approved the matter relating to awarding of one year Post Graduate Certificate on Police Management of Calcutta University to the successful / passed candidates who have completely passed in both indoor and outdoor subjects as applicable.
