No. 601-PL/PB/4P-25/13 dated 21st February, 2014: In exercise of the power conferred by clause(s) of section 2 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974) and in modification of all previous Notifications relating to the areas included within the Shibpur Police Station under the Howrah Police Commissionerate in the district of Howrah, the Governor is hereby pleased to declare that with effect from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette there shall be a Police Station at Chatterjeehat in the District of Howrah namely Chatterjeehat Police Station which shall consist of the areas, the description of which has been specified in the scheduled given below:

The Schedule

CHATTERJEEHAT POLICE STATION

Description of Areas and Boundaries

NORTH: Starting from point where the northern limit of Netaji Subhash Road meets the extended western limit of Vivekananda Road, thence proceeds westwards along the northern boundary of Netaji Subhash Road and Mahendra Nath Bhattacharjee Road up to a point where it meets the eastern limit of Barui Para 1st Bye Lane, thence proceeds northwards along the eastern limit of Barui Para 1st Bye Lane up to a point where it meets the southern limit of Dumurjala H.I.T. Quarter Road, thence crossing the Dumurjala H.I.T. Quarter Road it meets the northern limit of Dumurjala H.I.T. Quarter Road, thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Dumurjala H.I.T. Quarter Road up to the eastern limit of Howrah Drainage Canal Road, thence crossing the Howrah Drainage Canal Road it meets the northern limit of Dakshinpara H.I.T. Quarter Road, thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Dakshinpara H.I.T. Quarter Road up to a point where it meets the eastern limit of Kedar Nath Bhattacharjee Lane, thence crossing the Kedar Nath Bhattacharjee Lane, it proceeds southwards along the western limit of Kedar Nath Bhattacharjee Lane up to a point where it meets on the northern, limit of Mahendra Nath Bhattacharjee Road, thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Mahendra Nath Bhattacharjee Road up to a point where it meets on the eastern limit of Ram Charan Seth Road, thence proceeds north and westwards along the eastern limit of Ram Charan Seth Road up to a point where it meets on the eastern limit of Ambika Kundu Lane;

WEST: Starting from a point where the northern limit of Ram Charan Seth Road meets Ambika Kundu Lane, thence crossing Ram Charan Seth Road, thence proceeds southwards along the western limit of Ambika Kundu Lane up to a point where it meets the north-east limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track including lands;

SOUTH: Starting from a point where the western limit of Ambika Kundu Lane meets the north-east limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track including Lands, thence proceeds south-eastwards along the north-west limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track including land up to a point where it meets the eastern limit of Currie Road; and

EAST : Starting from a point where the eastern limit of Currie Road meets the north-east limit of Shalimar Santragachi Railway Track including Lands, thence proceeds northwards along the eastern limit of Currie Road, meets the northern limit of Shaikh Para 1st Bye Lane, thence proceeds eastwards along the northern limit of Shaikh Para 1st Bye Lane, up to a point where it meets the northern limit of Circular 2nd Bye Lane, there proceeds north-eastwards along the north-west limit of Circular 2nd Bye Lane, Shibpur Road and Aprakash Mukherjee Lane up to a point where it meets the northern limit of Koi Pukur Lane thence eastwards along the northern limit of Koi Pukur Lane up to a point where it meets the western limit of Chandra Kumar Banerjee Lane, thence proceeds along the western limit of Chandra Kumar Banerjee Lane, Nabin Senapati Lane and Vivekananda Road up to a point where it meets the northern limit of Netaji Subhash Road.

Description of Areas and Boundaries

NORTH: Starting from a point on the district boundary on the Hugli River, nearest to southern limit of the Ramkrishnapur Ghat Road, thence westwards in a straight line which meets the southern limit of Ramkrishnapur Ghat Road, thence proceeds westwards along the southern limit of Ramkrishnapur Ghat Road and Dr. Gangadhar Mukherjee Road, up to the eastern limit of Grand Trunk Road, thence crossing Grand Trunk Road it meets the northern limit of Nrisingha Bose Lane, thence proceeds westward along the northern limit of Nrisingha Bose Lane up to the point where it meets the eastern limit of Ramkrishnapur Lane, thence proceeds northwards along the eastern limit of Ramkrishnapur Lane and Nidhi Ram Majhi Lane up to the southern limit of Netaji Subhash Road, thence crossing the Netaji Subhash Road, it meets the northern limit of Netaji Subhash Road, thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Netaji Subhash Road up to the point where it meets the extended western limit Vivekananda Road;

WEST: Starting from a point where the northern limit of Netaji Subhash Road meets western limit of the Vivekananda Road, thence proceeds southwards along the western limit of Vivekananda Road, Nabin Senapati Lane, Chandra Kumar Banerjee Lane, up to a point where it meets the northern limit of Kaipukur Lane, thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Kaipukur Lane up to a point where it meets western limit of Aprakash Mukherjee Lane, thence proceeds southwards along the western limit of Aprakash Mukherjee Lane, Shibpur Road, thence proceeds southwards along the western limit of Circular 2nd Bye Lane up to a point where it meets northern limit of Shaikh Para 1st Bye Lane thence proceeds westwards along the northern limit of Shaikh Para 1st Bye Lane up to a point where it meets eastern limit of Currie Raod, thence proceeds southwards along the eastern limit of Currie Raod, up to a point where it meets the north-east limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track including Land;

SOUTH: Starting from a point where the eastern limit of Currie Raod meets the north-east limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track, thence proceeds southwards, along the north-east limit of Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track up to a point where it meets the district boundary along the Hugli River; and

EAST : Starting from a point on the district boundary on the Hugli River nearest to the Shalimar-Santragachi Railway Track including Lands, thence proceeds northwards along the district boundary up to a point where it meets nearest to the southern limit of Ramkrishnapur Ghat Road.
