Sub. : Sanction of Lump Sum Compensation of Rs. 300000/- (Three Lakhs) in case of death of Civic Volunteers/Village Police Volunteers/Casual workers under Police Establishment while on duty.

The undersigned is directed to refer to his office Memo. No. 633 Wel/Sahayak/C dated 17.06.2019 on the proposal for sanction of lump sum compensation of Rs. 500000/- (Five lakh) in case of death of Civic Volunteers/Village Police Volunteers/Casual wrkers while on duty and to say that the matter was under active consideration of the Government for some time past.

2) The matter was submitted to the Finance Department for their concurrence. The Finance Department, vide their U.O. No. Group P2/2019-2020/0838, dated 22.01.2020 has observed the following :

“This is a proposal for payment of a lump sum compensation of Rs. 5.00 Lakh in the event of death of Civic Volunteers, Village Police Volunteers and Casual Workers under Police Establishment, while on duty.

The proposal has been examined in the light of existing order concerning similar categories of workers engaged in non-police establishment. There is a provision for payment of a lump sum amount of Rs. 3.00 Lakh to casual, contractual and daily rated workers engaged in various Government Establishment in terms of No. 9008-F(P), on attaining the age of 60 or in the case of death after rendering at least 10 years of service.

In consonance with the abovementioned provision we may agree to the payment of Rs. 3.00 Lakh in the event of death of those volunteers and workers with a prospective effect.”

3) Now, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor, after careful consideration of the matter, has been pleased to agree for sanction of lump sum compensation of Rs. 300000/- (Three lakh) to the Next of Kin (NOK) of Civic

Volunteers/Village Police Volunteers/Casual Workers in the case of death while on duty, after rendering at least 10 years of service.

- 4) The incidence of death while on duty, is to be certified by the Commissioner of Police/Superintendent of Police.
- 5) The above compensation may be paid from the appropriate head of Account (Contingency Fund) in the State Police Budget.
- 6) The order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Group P2/2019-2020/0838, dated 22.01.2020.
- 7) The Principal Accountant General (A & E), West Bengal is being informed.
