The undersigned is directed to refer to the note of the Director General & Inspector General of Police, West Bengal vide No. IS-120/DG/2020, dated 09.09.2020 and IS-125/DG/2020, dated 10.09.2020 on the above subject and to say that a proposal for granting service benefits and other financial benefits in respect of Civic Volunteers under both the West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police and Village Police Volunteers under West Bengal Police was under active consideration of the Government for some time past.

2. Decision : After discussion the Board members have accepted the prayers of above mentioned police personnel to forgo the promotion to the Rank of ASI(UB)/SI(UB) respectively.

- Commissioner of Police , Howrah / Chandannagar, SP, Uttar Dinajpur / Cooch Behar, Superintendent of Railway Police, Sealdah /Howrah will strictly follow the G.O No-9120-F dtd.13/11/2000, of Finance Department, Audit Branch, Govt. of West Bengal in this regard. They will not be entitled to any benefit under CAS 1990 and it should be recorded in their service books with an intimation to DIG(Administration), West Bengal.
- As on date, there is no express provision in PRB/Police Order regarding non-willingness of police personnel for promotion. DIG(A) may examine and put up a proposal for approve of competent authority.

Miscellaneous :-

(i) **Consideration of Social Category of ASI(UB) 1069 Santimay Roy of Barrackpore PC.**

- Deputy Commissioner of Police (HQ) Barrackpore PC has reported under his Memo No.1399/RO,BKP dtd. 12/08/2019 has informed that the social category of ASI(UB)/ 1069 Santimay Roy of Barrackpore PC, may be treated as “Scheduled Caste” in place of “General” category. ASI(UB) 1069 Santimay Roy of Barrackpore PC was declared fit for promotion to the rank of SI (UB) at the time of L-C-R-S Board.
- The copy of the relevant caste certificate and District Order No.2375 dtd.12/8/2019 of DCP(HQ)BKP-was placed for consideration in the Board.

Decision : The Board has decided to treat the social category of ASI(UB)/1069 Santimay Roy of Barrackpore PC as Scheduled Caste.

(ii) **Promotion matter of LC/143 Krishna Dey of Malda district for promotion to the Rank of LASI(UB).**

- SP Malda has sent a letter vide his memo no.1385/RO dtd.17/09/2019 regarding promotion to the rank of LASI(UB) in respect of LC/143 Krishna Dey of Malda district.
- LC/143 Krishna Dey of Malda district was declared ‘fit’ for promotion to the rank of LASI(UB) in the meeting of BOC for Examination and Promotion and subsequently she was posted on promotion to Malda to the rank of LASI(UB) vide this office memo no.433(170)Per/A/Per/A-147/2010 dtd.05.03.2013.[sl-684]
- She submitted a prayer expressing her unwillingness to take promotion to the rank of LASI(UB) due to her distressed physical condition, which refers Malda district Order No.1042 dtd.02.05.2013. Accordingly in terms of Memo no. 1082(130) Per/A/Per/A 01/2012 dtd.07.06.2012 her 25 years CAS benefit was ceased.
- On 27/08/2019 LC/143 Krishna Dey again submitted a prayer expressing her willingness to take promotion to the rank of LASI(UB) as her physical condition has improved.
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

DECISION: After discussion the Board members decided that the case will be considered in the next BOC after getting all relevant documents including her Physical fitness Certificate for promotion to the rank of LASI(UB). SP, Malda will please inform how many times the LC has submitted unwillingness for promotion and how many times her name was not considered for promotion in the Range Board. SP, Malda is directed to refer her name to Range Board for detailed examination and relevant recommendation or otherwise.

(iii) **Promotion matter of C/522 Sisir Ghosh of SAP 6TH Bn. for promotion to the Rank of ASI(UB).**

- Commandant SAP 6TH Bn has sent a letter vide his memo no.2569/ dtd.18/09/2019 regarding disposal in respect of C/522 Sisir Ghosh of SAP 6th Bn who was qualified in departmental examination for promotion to the rank of ASI(UB).
- The matter was placed before the Board held on 28/10/2014 and 26/04/2017 with the report of L-C-R-S Board. The member of the Board examined the matter and declared him ‘unfit’ as per record due to and under currency of Punishment.
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

DECISION: The Members of the Board examined the matter and decided that the case will be considered after getting the opinion of the Range Board.

(iv) **Promotion matter of C/753 Rakesh Prasad of SAP 1st Bn. for promotion to the Rank of ASI(UB).**

- DIG(AP) Barrackpore has sent a letter vide his memo no.771/F55-2019 dtd.7/09/2019 regarding disposal in respect of C/753 Rakesh Prasad of SAP 1st Bn who was qualified in departmental examination for promotion to the rank of ASI(UB).
- The matter was placed before the Board held on 26/04/2017 with the report of L-C-R-S Board. The member of the Board examined the matter and dissolved that though he was declared ‘unfit’ as per record due to under currency of Punishment.

- The said constable was declared 'fit' in Range Board. But at his currency period of Punishment was not over, he was declared 'UNFIT' at the final Range Board.
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

DECISION: The members of the Board examined the matter and decided that the case will be considered after getting the opinion of the Range Board

(v) **Representation submitted by ASI(UB)/232 Nayan Maitra of Howrah GRP District presently attached with Integrated Head Quarter, West Bengal Railway Police.**

- DG & IGP, Railways West Bengal has sent a letter vide his memo no. 578/DGP(R)WB dtd.19/08/2019 regarding consideration for seniority as the candidate of ASI(UB) in the year 2010 the time of promotion to the rank of SI(UB) in respect of ASI(UB) 232 Nayan Maitra of Howrah GRP Districts presently attached with Integrated Head Quarter, West Bengal Railway Police.
- The then Constable-743 Nayan Maitra of Howrah district on deputation at WBHRC was posted on promotion as ASI(UB) to Howrah GRP vide memo no.803(92)-Per/A//Per/A-65/2009 dtd.26.04.2010 at SI No.349.
- The matching order regarding repatriation in r/o the then Constable-743 Nayan Maitra was issued from the Government vide memo no.504/2(9)/HS/HRC dated:04/06/2010 of Joint Secretary, Home (Special) Department, Human Rights Cell, Govt. of West Bengal
- The said ASI(UB) was released from the office of the Human Rights Commission on 14/06/2010 vide order no.173/WBHRC/21/10-11 dated:14/06/2010 of Dy. Secretary WBHRC, and joined Howrah GRP on promotion as ASI(UB) on 17/06/2010.
- ASI(UB) stated that due to procedural delay from the Government his joining was delayed.
- The said ASI(UB) requested to the competent authority to consider his seniority as ASIs(UB) of the year 2010 while getting promotion to the rank of SI(UB).
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

DECISION: The members of the Board examined the matter. The order for promotion of the incumbent was issued on 26.04.2010 and he joined as ASI(UB) on 17.06.2010 after 52 days. The delay in joining is not abnormal and also did not effect his increment and other financial benefits. Hence, the representation of the incumbent has been considered and rejected.

(vi) **Consideration of Prayer for exoneration of "Black Mark" for promotion to the Rank of Sub Inspector(UB) in respect of ASI(UB)/824 Aniruddha Sen of Barrackpore PC.**

- Commissioner of Police Barrackpore has forwarded a prayer vide his memo no.1542/RO, BKP dtd.03.09.2019 for exoneration of "Black Mark" for promotion to the Rank of Sub Inspector(UB) in respect of ASI(UB)/824 Aniruddha Sen of Barrackpore PC.
- ASI(UB)/824 Aniruddha Sen of Barrackpore PC for exoneration of punishment "Black Mark" awarded to him by the Disciplinary authority of Barrackpore PC in Barrackpore PC proceeding no.12/2018.
- Commissioner of Police Barrackpore also stated that during enquiry the main charges drawn up against ASI(UB)/824 Aniruddha Sen could not be substantiated but additional charge was passed by the disciplinary authority as "Black Mark" vide CO no.2123 dtd.23.07.2019.
- Commissioner of Police Barrackpore has requested to the competent authority for exoneration of "Black Mark" in respect of ASI(UB)/824 Aniruddha Sen as he is on the verge of promotion to the rank of SI(UB).
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

DECISION: The matter has been discussed by the members of the board. It is stated that the Board is not competent authority for exoneration of 'Black Mark'. In this respect a proposal has already been moved to the Government by DG & IGP, West Bengal vide this office Memo. No. 4344 ADM/D dtd. 26/09/2016.No order from Govt. has been received till now. DIG(A) to pursue the matter.

(vii) **Consideration for promotion of ASI/101 Manu Chandra Saha of Photo Section of IB West Bengal to the rank of SI(UB) of Police in Photo Section of IB, WB.**

- Dy. Inspector General of Police, IB, West Bengal has a sent consolidated proposal under his Memo No. 293/RO, dtd.14/03/2020 regarding consideration of ASI – 101 Manu Chandra Saha Photo Section of IB, WB, for Promotion to the rank of SI of Police in Photo Section of IB, WB.
- A Broad sheet of Board i.e L-C-R-S in this regard is also received from Special Assistant to ADG, IB, West Bengal, vide memo no. 618/RO, Dtd-30.07.2020. A board comprising Special Assistant to ADG, IB, West Bengal, Special Superintendent of Police, of IB, West Bengal, and DIG, IB West Bengal, adjusted the suitability of the incumbent and declared him “Fit” for promotion to the rank of SI of police in Photo Section of IB WB.
- In terms of regulation No.741(E)e of PRB vol-I, 1943 and G.O no.2936-PL/PI/8C-12/04 (Pt-I) Dtd.24.07.2008 of Home Police Department, the Police personnel of photographic Bureau of CID, WB and IB, WB may be allowed for exemption to appear in the written test of departmental examination to the next higher rank subject to the condition that they will not claim promotion to the next higher rank anywhere except in Photographic Bureau of CID, WB and IB, WB respectively.
- The matter was placed before BOC for Examination and Promotion for Decision.

Decision : The proposal is approved. The Board members opined that promotion order of ASI-101 Manu Chandra Saha of Photo Section of IB, WB to the rank of SI in Photo Section in IB, WB, may be issued.
