**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF CONTROL FOR
EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION HELD ON 13.02.2023**

A meeting of the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion was held on **13.02.2023** at **16:00** hrs. in the DGP'S Conference Hall, at Bhabani Bhawan, Kolkata-27.

Shri Ajey Mukund Ranade, IPS, Additional Director General & Inspector General of Police (Administration), West Bengal, the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting.

The following members of the Board attended the meeting:-

2. Shri Rishikesh Meena, IPS, Inspector General of Police (Org), West Bengal. Holding additional charge of Inspector Genl. of Police (Administration) West Bengal.
3. Shri. Joy Biswas, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police (Provisioning), West Bengal & holding charge of Deputy Inspector General of Police (Planning & Welfare), West Bengal.
4. Shri Sushil Kumar Dutta, Joint Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal, Home and Hill Affairs Department.

The following points were discussed in the meeting of BOC for Examination & Promotion.

To examine Length-cum-Record of Service Book of 05(Five) Wireless Operators for promotion to the rank of Supervisors(Technical) Grade-II

- ADG & IGP Telecom, WB vide Memo No.-18/RO dated:07-02-2023 has submitted the Broad Sheet for consideration of Wireless Operators for promotion to the rank of Supervisor(Technical) Grade-II in respect of 05(Five) candidates. Perused the Broad Sheet reflecting marks obtain in PPT Course and LCRS Part-III results. All are declared FIT for Promotion to SR(T)-II. RO Telecom, WB has submitted vacancy status of SR(T)-II which is kept in record. It is seen from the statement that at present there is 11(Eleven) vacancies in the rank of Supervisor (Technical) Grade-II. Hence, the competent authority of Telecommunication Branch of West Bengal Police is directed to accord Promotion to 05(Five) Wireless Operators subject to their seniority in the Gradation List, subject to clearance from the angle of pending departmental proceeding, currency of punishment in respect of departmental proceeding criminal case, vigilance enquiry etc on the date of according promotion including following 50 point roaster strictly.

DECISION: The Board examined the result and approved of the same for next course of action. 05(Five) Wireless Operators may be promoted in the existing vacancy subject to seniority as per Gradation List and maintaining 50 point Roaster.

(1) To examine Length-cum-Record of Service Book of 48(Forty Eight) Wireless Operators for promotion to the rank of Supervisors(Operational) Grade-II

- ADG & IGP Telecom, WB vide Memo No.-18/RO dated:07-02-2023 has submitted the Broad Sheet for consideration of Wireless Operators for promotion to the rank of Supervisor(Operational) Grade-II in respect of 48(Forty Eight) candidates. Perused the Broad Sheet reflecting marks obtain in PPT Course and LCRS Part-III results. All are declared FIT for Promotion to SR(O)-II. RO Telecom, WB has submitted vacancy status of SR(T)-II which is kept in record. It is seen from the statement that at present there is sanction strength of 87 departmental post of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II as per Recruitment Rules Vide No.-3531-PL/PI/8C-15/07 Dated: 04-12-2018. But the actual strength in the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II is 95(Ninety Five) which as on date exceeds the actual strength by 08(Eight).

DECISION: The Board examined the result. As per new Recruitment Rules Vide No.-3531-PL/PI/8C-15/07 Dated: 04-12-2018 50% of the combined sanctioned strength of Wireless Supervisor(T) Grade-II and Wireless Supervisor(O) Grade-II in West Bengal Police shall be filled up by promotion from the post of Wireless Operators. The sanctioned strength of SR(O)-II is 173(One Hundred and Seventy Three).The sanctioned strength as per new Rule mentioned above in respect of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II is 87(Eighty Seven). But, the actual strength is 95(Ninety Five) in (in departmental quota) as on date which exceeds the actual strength by 8(Eight). Hence, as on date, there is no vacancy in respect of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II.

Hence, the 48 Wireless Operators who were declared FIT for promotion in the Range Board and also FIT for promotion in this BOC cannot be promoted due to unavailability of vacancy in the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II.

(2) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Post-Promotional Training Course of Inspectors of Police (UB), WBP of Batch No.-28/2022 .

- Total 115 (One Hundred Fifteen) Inspectors of Police (UB) reported at SVSPA,BKP, to undergo the aforesaid training.They Completed the Training and appeared in the final Examination in the all subjects and qualified successfully.
- The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control for Examination and Promotion' for perusal and approval.

DECISION: The Board examined the result and approved of the same for next course of action. 115(One Hundred Fifteen) Inspectors of Police (UB) have qualified the Post-Promotional training to the rank of Inspectors of Police (UB).

(3) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Pre-Promotional Training Course of Constables (UB) for promotion to the rank of ASI (UB), WBP of Batch No.- 14/2022-23 .

- IGP, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam.sec/ PPT/ Const. (UB)/ 05(VII)/2018-490 DTD- 13.02.2023, the Result of the Final Examination of Pre-Promotional Training Course of Constables for promotion to the rank of ASIs (UB), WBP of Batch No.- 14/2022-23 Commenced on and from 21.11.2022 and ended on 24.01.2023.
- Total 878 (Eight Hundred Seventy eight) Constables reported at PTS, Salua, Paschim Medinipur to undergo the aforesaid training. Out of them 875(Eight Hundred Seventy Five) constables Completed the Training and appeared in the final Examination in the all subjects and qualified successfully.
03(Three) constables did not appear in the final examination due to unauthorised absence.
