NOTIFICATION

No 257-PAR(TRG)/HR/O/3T-19/2023 dated Howrah, the 31st day of August, 2023, – In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendment in the Services (Training and Examination) Rules, West Bengal, issued with the Finance (Audit) Department vide notification No. 845-F, dated the 19th March, 1953, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules) :-

Amendment

In the said rules, in CHAPTER II, under the heading “(A) General rules regarding Departmental Examinations”-

(1) after rule (13), insert the following rule :-

“14, Notwithstanding anything contrary contained in any other provisions of these rules, an officer who has completely passed Half-Yearly Departmental Examination during his tenure in the West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) cadre and subsequently joined West Bengal Police Service cadre or vice-versa, shall be exempted from appearing further in Half-Yearly Departmental Examination :

Provided that the concerned officer shall undergo administrative training including a condensed course on the relevant subjects for a period of one week in subsequent cadre.”

- Syllabus of Wireless Operators was approved in BoC dated 20.04.2022. However, in the said syllabus. Also pass marks of theoretical subjects of technical and operational training have been modified to 40 marks in parity with other subjects. Number of classes in certain subjects were missing and also the said syllabus was not drafted in Detailed Block Syllabus format. Today revised syllabus incorporating the same, was put up for approval which was unanimously approved by the Board.
 - Pursuant to the minutes of the meeting at the office of ADG & IGP(A), WB, Dt. 23.08.2023 vide Sl. No. 12 (Incorporation of Cyber investigation Content in the training Syllabus of Wireless operators), the Board deliberated upon the feasibility of including training on cyber crime in the basic course. However, considering the existing allocation of classes in basic training, the Board opined training on cyber crime for the wireless operators may be conducted in different batches after completion of their basic training. In this connection, SVSPA will prepare modular syllabus of Cybercrime investigation considering the fact that wireless operators may be engaged for technical support in crime scene processing and analysis of digital evidence only.
 - Regarding the Agenda No. 2 draft syllabus of Police Band training as prepared by SVSPA after taking the inputs of the Committee formed in pursuance to directions issued in the BoC dated 22.02.2023 was placed before the board members IG SVSPA informed that one option is to consider adopting syllabus already used by other State police forces e.g. Rajasthan Police or syllabus of Army in its entirety rather than developing new syllabus for want of sufficient expertise. The Board resolved that the syllabus should be sent to more experts/experienced senior officers for seeking their comments/opinion and thereafter, the Board will finalize the Police Band Training Syllabus.

1) Approval of the result of the final examination of the RCs of Batch No. 223/2023.

- Out of 185 trainees, 02 trainees namely RC/19 Bablu Baskey of SVSPA and RC/142 Tapas Sarkar of SVSPA resigned from the service.
- RC/91 Rajesh Mondal and RC/116 Simanta Tudu both of SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore are absent from training for more than 25% of the prescribed training duration. They are treated as Batch reverted and they will undergo training in next batch.
- RC/7 Amit Biswas of SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore was absent from training for more than 15% of the prescribed training duration. He will be treated as detained.
- RC/101 Sajib Sikdar of SVSPA, Barrackpore failed to appear in Paper-I and II of the indoor subject. He will be treated as detained.
- RC/114 Shuvajit Ghosh of SVSPA, Barrackpore failed in three outdoor subjects. He will be treated as detained.
- The detained candidates will appear supplementary examination after undergoing training for one month.
- Out of 185 RCs, 178 RCs have successfully passed both in indoor and outdoor subjects.
- The result sheet of Recruit Constables of Batch No. 223/23 was placed before the members of BOC for Training and BoC approved the same.

2) Approval of the result of the final examination of Wireless Supervisor (Tech) Grade-II of WB Police of Batch No. 24/2023.

- Out of 68 trainees of Wireless Supervisor Grade-II, WSG-II/07-Arup Kumar Das of SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore resigned from service.
- 8 Wireless Supervisor Grade-II, WSG-II/01-Abhijit Kundu, WSG-II/06-Arun Subba, WSG-II/08-Ashish Biswas, WSG-II/10-Biprajit Mondal, WSG-II/13-

 - The members of BOC have decided to pass Wireless Supervisor Grade-II, WSG-II/1-Abhijit Kundu and WSG-II/17-Indadul Mondal in Paper-I (General Studies) of Indoor Subject and WSG-II/57-Dipsikha Roy, WSG-II/60-Monija Khatun and WSG-II/61-Tanusree Majumder in physical training of Outdoor subject by awarding grace marks to them.
 - Rest 8 Wireless Supervisor Grade-II, WSG-II/6-Arun Subba, WSG-II/08-Ashish Biswas, WSG-II/10-Biprajit Mondal, WSG-II/13-Chhogel Bhutia, WSG-II/16-Fardinand Kullu, WSG-II/19-Kallol Das, WSG-II/58-Karabi Saha and WSG-II/59-Madhurima Dey may appear in supplementary examinations to be held later. Sub. : Creation of 1744 (One thousand seven hundred forty four) posts in different categories under Kolkata Police along with engagement of 4 Engineers of different categories for Bhangar Division under Kolkata Police.

1. Eight Police Stations, namely, (1) Hatishala Police Station, (2) Polerhat Police Station, (3) Uttar Kashipur Police Station, (4) Bijoyganj Bazar Police Station, (5) Madhabpur Police Station, (6) Chandaneswar Police Station, (7) Bodra Police Station, (8) Bhangar Police Station, (Re-defined & reduced jurisdiction) have been created under this Department Notification Nos. 2102-PL, 2103-PL, 2104-PL, 2105-PL, 2106-PL, 2107-PL, 2108-PL, & 2110-PL all dated 16.08.2023 respectively by way of division/re-organisation of areas previously comprised in 03 (three) Police Stations, namely Kolkata Leather Complex Police Station, Kashipur Police Station and Bhangar Police Station.
2. In terms of this Department's Notification No. 2111-PL dated 16.08.2023 Kashipur Police Station has ceased to exist after re-organisation of the areas previously under the jurisdiction of Kashipur Police Station into the newly created/existing police stations.
3. In terms of this Department's Notification 2109-PL dated 16.08.2023 Kolkata Leather Complex Police Station will continue to function within its re-defined and reduced jurisdictions under existing "East Division" of Kolkata Police.
4. In terms of this Department's Notification No. 2156-PL dated 22.08.2023 a new Division named "Bhangar Division" under Kolkata Police has been created.
5. In terms of this Department's Notification No. 2157-PL dated 22.08.2023 "Bhangar Traffic Guard" has been created under Bhangar Division.
