Police Order No. 01 of 2020

Subject : Preparation of Range Approved List (RAL) of Police Office Clerks for promotion/appointment to the post of Upper Division Clerks, Cashier, Accountant, Reader Clerk and Had Clerk.

Consequent upon creation of new Police Districts, Police Commissionerates, Battalions and other units, it has been felt necessary to re-group the districts, police commissionerates, battalions and units for the purpose of preparation of Range Approved List (RAL) of Lower Division Clerks for promotion to the post of Upper Division Clerks and Upper Division Clerks for promotion/appointment to the post of Cashier, Accountant, Reader Clerk and Head clerk.

Minutes of the meeting of BoC for Training held on 12.12.2024 at 12:30 hrs. at the office chamber of ADGP & IGP, Training, WB, Salt Lake, Kolkata.

Dr. R. Rajasekaran, IPS, Additional Director General & Inspector general of Police, Training, West Bengal presided over the meeting.

Following officers of the 'Board of Control for Training' also attended the meeting :-

1. Shri Murli Dhar, IPS, IGP, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore.
2. Shri Arindam Dutta Chowdhury, IPS, DIGP (Administration), WB.
3. Shri Rashid Munir Khan, IPS, DIGP (HQ), WB.
4. Shri Deepanjan De, Sr. Deputy Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Dept., Govt. of WB.

Following points were submitted for the discussion and decision there upon by the Board :

1. Approval of the Semester – I result of Dy. SP (Probationers) Batch No. 72/2024-25.

21 (Twenty one) Dy. SP (Probationers), Batch No. 72/2024-25 joined on 15.04.2024 at SVSPA, Barrackpore, West Bengal. Out of 21, 01 (One) probationer has not appeared in the examination on medical ground. 20 (Twenty) Dy. SP (Probationers) have appeared in examination and qualified successfully. The result sheet of 1st Semester Examination (held in the month of Nov. 2024) was placed before the members of BoC. The members of the board unanimously approved the same.

2. Approval of the Final Result of Wireless Supervisor Gr. – II, (Technical & Operational) of Batch No. 24/23-24.

Total 67 Wireless Supervisors of Batch No. 24/23-24 were trained for Indoor Theory and Practical training at Telecom Head Quarters, West Bengal. 03 (Three) Wireless Supervisors have resigned and 3 (Three) Wireless Supervisors have been debarred for using unfair means during examination. Total 61 Wireless Supervisors appeared in the examination and all of them have qualified in all the papers. The result sheet of Final Examination of Wireless Supervisor (held in the month of Nov. 2024) was placed before the members of BoC. The Board approved the same.

Total 8 Wireless Supervisors of Batch No. 24/23024 Gr – II, (Technical & Operational) undergone Basic training at SVSPA, Barrackpore, West Bengal and could not succeed in all the papers during final examination of basic training. All of them (08) appeared in supplementary examination (held in the month of Nov. 2024) for their failed papers and qualified successfully. The result sheet of Supplementary Examination was placed before the members of BoC and the Board unanimously approved the same.

3) Approval of the Final Result of Wireless operator Batch No. 25/23-24.

977 Wireless Operators, Batch No. 25/23-24 were trained for Indoor Theory and Practical training at PTS Salua. Out of 977 (Nine hundred seventy seven), 08 (Eight) Wireless Operator have resigned and 01 expired. Total 968 Wireless Operator appeared in the examination (held in the month of Nov. 2024) and 2 Candidates have not qualified in all papers, they will appear in supplementary examination as and when held by SVSPA. 966 (Nine hundred sixty six) qualified successfully. Result was placed before the BoC. The members of the board unanimously approved the same.

Total 12 Wireless Operators of Batch No. 25/23-24 (Technical & Operational) who undergone Basic training at SVSPA, Barrackpore, West Bengal and could not succeed in swimming during final examination of basic training. Out of 12 (Twelve), 2 (two) candidates resigned and 10 (Ten) appeared in supplementary examination (held in the month of Nov. 2024) for swimming and 09 (nine) qualified successfully. 01 (one) candidate will appear in supplementary Examination as and when held by SVSPA. The result sheet of Supplementary Examination was placed before the members of BoC. The members of the board unanimously approved the same.

4) Approval of the Final Result of Supplementary Examination of Detained LRC of Batch No. 227/2024 & detained RC of Batch No. 224/23-24.

Total 02 detained LRC/RC of Batch No. 227/2024 and of Batch No. 224/23-24 respectively appeared in the Supplementary Examination (held in the month of Nov. 2024) and both of them have qualified in all papers. Result sheet was placed before the BoC. The members of the board approved the same.

5) Approval of revised syllabus of West Bengal Police Band.

A proposal for draft syllabus of West Bengal Police Band was placed before the BoC on 21.09.2023 where the members of the board opined for taking inputs of the committee formed in this regard and opined that the syllabus of others state police forces i.e. Rajasthan Police or syllabus of Army and also the opinion of experts/experiences of senior officers may be taken in consideration for developing the new syllabus of the academy. Pursuance to the above decisions, the draft syllabus of West Bengal Police Band has been prepared taking inputs of the syllabus of the Rajputana Rifles, Syllabus of Rajasthan Police and the syllabus of Eastern Command Music course. The draft syllabus has been placed before the board members of BoC. The board has granted 'provisional approval' on the revised syllabus of West Bengal Police Band with few suggestions i.e. the training will be continued according to this syllabus and in the mean time the syllabus to be shared with senior police officers for obtaining their opinion for its up gradation. Thereafter, final syllabus of West Bengal Police Band will be placed before BoC for its approval.

6. Approval of Arming Policy of West Bengal Police.

In light of suggestions of committee forming Arming Policy, proposal to make necessary amendments in firing syllabi of different trainee was placed before the Board members. The board has approved the same with minor changes and as per decision of the board, this will be reflected in all the training syllabi of academy.

7) Miscellaneous :-

It appears from the Police Training Manual – 2014 (vide Vol. – II, page no. 82 & 83 under captioned ‘Standing Decisions’) that any trainee undergoing basic training and absents due to leave or otherwise above 15% and upto 25% of the prescribed training duration shall be detained for a certain period of days and thereafter he/she will appear in supplementary examination. Any trainee undergoing basic training and absents due to leave or otherwise for more than 25% of the prescribed training duration shall be ordered for Batch Reversion.

Similar kind of regulation should be extended to the trainee absents in pre/post promotional training.

In case of pre/post promotional training, if any trainee absents due to leave or otherwise above 15% and up to 25% of the prescribed training duration, he or she will not be allowed to appear in the examination with the same batch. He or she will subsequently appear only for the examination with the next batch. Any trainee undergoing pre/post promotional training and absents due to leave or otherwise more than 25%, he or she shall be ordered for Batch Reversion.
